Moving on from primary school to year 5 – general information

Dear parents,

Your child is beginning a new phase of life. Their time at primary school is coming to an end and they will soon change to year 5. Your child will make new friends and will usually have to travel a little further than their immediate home area to attend school. With this flyer we would like to give you some important information regarding this major step towards independence.

The city of Oldenburg has a wide selection of schools which your child can attend from year 5: Oberschulen (upper schools), Integrierte Gesamtschulen (integrated comprehensive schools) and Gymnasien (academic high schools). They can also continue to attend a Förderschule (school for children with learning difficulties). Every one of these schools does exceptional work. We therefore recommend that you find out about what all the different schools have to offer. A good way to start is to take a look at the website of the schools.

Places are limited in all of the schools, so please pay attention to the registration dates on the reverse. Only then will you have the greatest possible chance of getting a place for your child at your chosen school

Oberschulen (upper schools)

The Oberschule Alexanderstraße, Oberschule Eversten, Oberschule Ofenerdiek and Oberschule Osternburg are owned by the city of Oldenburg. In all these schools the pupils are not streamed (taught in groups according to educational ability) in the initial years.

At the upper schools the pupils can learn a second foreign language as well as develop a focus on either economics, technology or health and social subjects. The high level of practical experience offered, as well as solid career orientation, are particularly outstanding. All leaving examinations of the Sekundarbereich I (secondary level I) can be taken at these upper schools. If the pupils achieve the Erweiterter Sekundarabschluss I (extended secondary examination I) in year 10 they are allowed to attend the Oberstufe (senior level) at an academic high school (Gymnasium) or a comprehensive school (Gesamtschule). This educational route then leads to the general higher education entrance qualification (Abitur) required to attend universities etc.

You should register at the school you are interested in for your child. Every child is guaranteed a place in an upper school. However the Oldenburg City Council has decided on fixed processes to speed up the procedure. This means that if there are too many registrations, you are not entitled to have a place at a specific upper school. We therefore recommend that you give a second and also possibly a third choice on your registration form, in order to increase the chances of gaining a place at one of these schools.

Integrierte Gesamtschulen (integrated comprehensive schools)

The Integrierte Gesamtschule Helene-Lange-Schule, Integrierte Gesamtschule Flötenteich and Integrierte Gesamtschule Kreyenbrück are owned by the city of Oldenburg. The schools have different profiles. In all these integrated comprehensive schools the pupils are not streamed (taught in groups according to educational ability) in the initial years. At the senior level (Oberstufe), the schools work together with the academic high schools (Gymnasien), meaning that pupils have the choice of almost any combination of subjects.

The integrated comprehensive schools enable pupils to develop a specialist focus; for example French or Spanish can be learned as a second foreign language. All leaving examinations of the Sekundarbereich I and also the general university entrance qualification (Abitur) can be taken.



In the initial years, the pupils do not receive attainment grades but learning development reports instead. Pupils progress automatically to the next year up to year 10 (i.e. pupils cannot be forced to repeat a year).

You should register at the school you are interested in for your child. There is no automatic entitlement to a place in an integrated comprehensive school. It is therefore a good idea to think about possible alternative schools if your child does not get a place at your first choice school.

Gymnasien (academic high schools)

The Alte Gymnasium, Gymnasium Cäcilienschule, Gymnasium Eversten, Herbartgymnasium and the Neue Gymnasium are owned by the city of Oldenburg. The schools have different profiles. All Gymnasien (academic high schools) have their own senior level (Oberstufe) that leads to the higher education entrance qualification (Abitur) necessary to attend university etc. At the same time, all the academic high schools work together and also with the integrated comprehensive schools, meaning that pupils can almost always study their chosen subjects.

You should register at the school you are interested in for your child. Every child is guaranteed a place at an academic high school. However the Oldenburg City Council has decided on fixed processes to speed up the procedure. This means that if there are too many registrations, you are not entitled to have a place at a specific academic high school. We therefore recommend that you give a second and also possibly a third choice on your registration form, in order to increase the chances of gaining a place at one of these schools.
